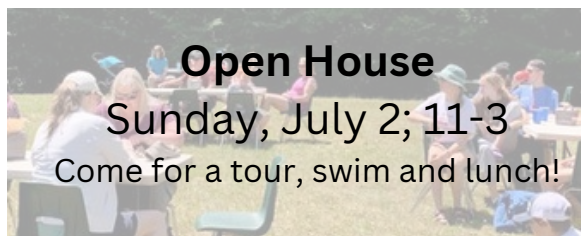

supervision.

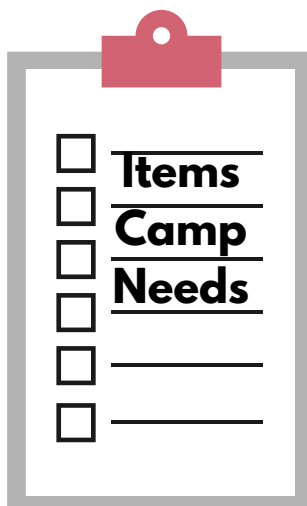
Adults sleep in the tents with the campers.
